## Surviving The Pandemic

### LOWER HUDSON VALLEY AREA

In March 2020, New York State was placed in a mandatory lockdown and we were unable to host meetings in-person. Luckily, Lower Hudson Valley is a very small area with only nine member groups. This can be challenging at times in terms of filling commitments and attracting trusted servants, but it actually was to our advantage during a pandemic.

Our Area Service Committee met immediately and decided to maintain a single Zoom ID for the use of our entire area. The groups then agreed to 'host' a slot which was primarily consistent with the day of the week that they met. The groups also voted to standardize the meeting time from 7:30 to 9:00 PM every night of the week so that members only needed to remember one Zoom ID and could find a meeting being held there at the same time every day. It was truly a privilege to witness the unity of the Area as everyone came together for the greater good of addicts seeking recovery.

Almost eighteen months later, we have four groups that have resumed meeting in-person exclusively, one group is maintaining a hybrid format, and the remaining four groups have remained virtual.



Our area has been supported by new virtual members who live in multiple states and several different countries. This would not have been possible except that we were a consistent and steady resource for addicts to find recovery. It appears that virtual meetings will remain in our area for the foreseeable future, and hope that you will come and recover with us one day!
